| Decision Made: | To enter into a contract with Calfordseaden LLP (company registration number OC315838) for the Carnarvon Terrace project which is being delivered as part of the wider Clacton Civic Quarter Levelling Up Fund scheme, and Pellings LLP (company registration number OC326178, subsidiary of RSK Group Ltd) for the Homes in Dovercourt project, which is being delivered as part of the Dovercourt Town Centre Improvement Corridor scheme, for the provision of Principal Designer services for both projects mentioned.
