# A.2 - REFERENCE REPORT FROM THE COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP AND PARTNERSHIPS COMMITTEE OF 15 APRIL 2013

### CIVIC HUB PROJECT – REVIEW OF PROGRESS

#### BACKGROUND

At the meeting on 15 April 2013, the Community Leadership and Partnerships Committee considered the issue of the Civic Hub Project – Review of Progress.

The Committee received a presentation by the Corporate Director (Corporate Services) and the Council's Asset Manager, who advised the Committee that the Civic Hub Project aimed to rationalise Tendring District and Essex County Council's office accommodation and, in doing so, encourage more modern ways of working and the creation of a "front door" one stop shop approach to conducting the Council's affairs. It was hoped that the new Hub would enable the integration of the library and adult learning experience, together with primary care and health education.

The Asset Manager concluded that a full feasibility study of the proposals would be required, including detailed consideration of how the shared services elements would work and detailed work on the IT and building adaption components of the Project.
