BEACH HUT STRATEGY

BACKGROUND

At the meeting on 11 March 2013, the Service Development and Delivery Committee considered the issues of the Council's beach hut strategy.

The Committee received a presentation by the Council's Streets and Seafronts Manager which gave details of the Tendring District Beach Huts Strategy and Policy Business Planning for the Council's beach huts in five areas across the Tendring District. The Committee was advised that, currently, there were 3,039 beach huts, which were producing a net income of over £800,000 per year and that demand for these remained high on waiting lists in prime locations.
