Decision Made:	To cease the out of hours service supported by the Dog Wardens as part of the Street scene team.

Reason for Decision (if a Service unsustainable based upon two officers to produced report was providing a 24/7 stray dog service. support the Decision, refer to Also due to universal credit, Dog Warden financially or attach it): poorer due to the out of hours service payments and consequently has given notice to guit the out of hours service. See attached briefing note. Highlight associated any Main area of work covered by the out of hour's service risks/finance/legal/equality is the stray dog service. Finders of stray dogs directed considerations: to take dogs direct to boarding kennels (8am to 7pm) or hold on until next working day if outside of these hours. This decision will affect finders of stray dogs who do not or cannot drive. Cost of stray dogs being sent direct to boarding kennel will be responsibility of the owners. Service no longer a 24 hour service, however majority of stray dogs reported to the authority via Careline are between 8am and 7pm Out of hours service also incorporates dead animals (seals on beaches, reports of sharps on public land and fly tipping posing a public health risk or blocking a public highway); however these reports are minimal and could be incorporated into anther out of hour's service, passed direct to the contractor or on an adhoc basis by the Street Scene Manager in the interim.
