I confirm that I am making the following executive decision:-

To formally name the new roads under construction at the development site – Land South of Bromley Road, Ardleigh, Colchester, Essex as follows:-

“Redmason Road”, “Carder Close”, “Hawker Place”, “Pipistrelle Place”, “Beehive Way”, “Cedarcup Close”, “Harlequin Way”, “Meadows Close” and “Brook Marsh Place”.

Reasons:-

The parish Councillors and Village Archivist would like to focus on the flora and fauna found in the vicinity of the site, with particular emphasis on bees, given the close proximity to the former Beehive Public House – the names suggested come from details of the wildlife according to the ecology survey and published information about Salary Brook Nature Reserve.

I understand that a consultation with the relevant Ward Members and Parish Council that serve the Ardleigh & Lt Bromley Ward has taken place and all members are in agreement.
