Conditions


- 1 The development must be carried out where approval has been given by the local planning authority, within a period of 5 years from the date on which approval was given.

- 3 The development must, except to the extent that the local planning authority otherwise agree in writing, be carried out where prior approval is not required, in accordance with the details submitted with the application.
