## **ASSESSMENT**

The attached photographs shows that this work is reasonably necessary in order to manage these trees in the Manningtree section of this conservation area. Essex County Council -Place Services have attended a site meeting to give arboricultural advice today and have no objection to the work which they regard as satisfactory.

The work proposed is on a separate garden to the main property which was added to the overall property some years ago.

The pear involved is a common species and not a rare black pear and therefore issues as to protected species do not arise. The plum is self—planted having grown from a seed. One of the conifers to be felled is now starting to lean towards a nearby army cadet hall with the risk of casualties if it should suddenly fall. The pear and plum will remain to contribute towards the Conservation area once work takes place. The coppicing of the hazel trees is a long standing management practice for this variety. Although the proposal will lose two conifers from the conservation area the section of garden concerned will remain well wooded. The conifers are not of a particularly rare variety.

The intended work will overall contribute towards the preservation of the conservation area. There have been no objections or representations received
