However, secure tenants have a statutory right to undertake alterations, subject to permission being granted, and this right is not subject to the payment of any charges.  If the tenant is required to meet this charge they will be financially disadvantaged and treated in a different manner to other secure tenants simply by virtue of having been allocated this property.
