I refer to the above application received on 15 October 2020.

This is the Council's decision under Schedule 2, Part 11 Class B of The Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015.

The Council does not need details of the proposal and prior approval is not therefore required. This decision is valid for five years and will expire on 15 October 2025.

## Advisory Notes for the Control of Pollution during Construction and demolition Works

The following information is intended as guidance for applicants / developers and construction firms. In order to minimise potential nuisance to nearby existing residents caused by construction and demolition works, Environmental Control recommends that the following guidelines are followed. Adherence to this advisory note will significantly reduce the likelihood of public complaint and potential enforcement action by Environmental Control.

No vehicle connected with the works to arrive on site before 07:30 or leave after 19:00 (except in the case of emergency). Working hours to be restricted between 08:00 and 18:00 Monday to Saturday (finishing at 13:00 on Saturday) with no working of any kind permitted on Sundays or any Public/Bank Holidays.

These hours may be altered and further restricted at the discretion of Tendring District Council's Environmental Services in sensitive areas and neighbourhoods or for particularly noisy operations.

Any works outside the permitted hours are to be by prior approval of the Tendring District Council's Environmental Services.



Note: Approval will not be granted other than in exceptional circumstances and will be conditional on the contractor informing local residents in advance of the proposed activity.

No materials produced as a result of the site clearance shall be burned on site.

All reasonable steps, including damping down site roads, shall be taken to minimise dust and litter emissions from the site whilst works of demolition are in progress.
