By ANDREW JAMES HOBBINS and MAXINE ANNE HOBBINS of 41 First Avenue, Clacton-on-Sea, Essex CO15 5AJ and of Greenways, Church Lane, Great Holland, Frinton-on-Sea, Essex CO13 0JS ("the Landowner")

RECITALS

- 1. Tendring District Council of Town Hall, Station Road, Clacton-on-Sea, Essex CO15 1SE ("the Council") is the Local Planning Authority for the purposes of this Deed for the area within which the land described in the First Schedule ("the Land") is situated and by whom the obligations contained in this Deed are enforceable.

 2. The Landowner is a person interested in the Land as freehold owner.
- 3. An application Reference 20/01449/FUL ("the Planning Application") has been made for permission to develop the Land in the manner and for the uses set out in the Planning Application and in the plans specifications and particulars deposited with the Council and forming part of the Planning Application more particularly set out in the Second Schedule ("the Development"). The Planning Application is similar to that approved for Plot 1 of planning application 19/00560/OUT details with provided 20/00301/DETAIL which was approved following the completion of a planning obligation dated 30 May 2019 requiring payment of a RAMs and Open Space contributions.
- 4. This Deed is enforceable should planning permission be granted by the Council or subsequently granted on appeal following the refusal of the application by the Council.
- 5. The Council has not determined the Planning Application and the Landowner enters into this obligation to the intent that any objections by the Council to the grant of planning permission are overcome.

NOW THIS DEED is made in pursuance of section 106 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and is a planning obligation for the purposes of that section.

WITNESSES and as follows:

- 1. The Landowner covenants with the Council to perform the obligations specified in the Third and Fifth Schedules.
- 2. It is declared as follows:
- 2.1 The obligations in this Deed shall be enforceable in accordance with the provisions of section 106(3) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.
- 2.2 No person shall be liable for breach of a covenant contained in this Deed after he shall have parted with all interest in the Land or the part in respect of which such breach occurs but without prejudice to liability for any subsisting breach of covenant prior to parting with such interest.
- 2.3 The covenants contained in this Deed shall take effect on the date of this deed.
- 2.4 If the permission granted pursuant to the Planning Application shall expire before the Development is begun as defined above or shall at any time be revoked this Deed shall forthwith determine and cease to have effect.
- 2.5 Nothing in the Deed shall prohibit or limit the right to develop any part of the Land in accordance with a planning permission (other than one relating to the Development as specified in the Planning Application) granted (whether or not on appeal) after the date of this Deed.
- 2.6 This Deed is a local land charge and shall be registered as such.
- 2.7 The Landowner requires the Council to use the sum paid in accordance with the Third Schedule for the purpose of mitigating harm arising from the Development at the Special Protection Area, Special Areas of Conservation and Ramsar site designated primarily to protect waders & wildfowl specified in the

Fourth Schedule.

- 2.8 The Landowner requires the Council to use the sum paid in accordance with the Fifth Schedule for improvements to the Public Open Space specified in the Sixth Schedule.
- 2.9 The Landowner intends to build the Development permitted by 20/01449/FUL which increases the bedroom numbers from 3 to 4 bedrooms over that approved previously and asks the Council to transfer the payments made on 24/11/2020 under the planning obligation of 30 May 2019 to satisfy in part the payments required under this deed.

IN WITNESS whereof these presents have been duly executed as a Deed by the Landowner hereto the day and year first before written.

FIRST SCHEDULE "the Land"

Part of the freehold property known as Greenways, Church Lane, Great Holland, Frinton-on-Sea CO13 0JS registered at H M Land Registry under title number EX968046 for the purposes of identification only shown edged red on the plan attached to or incorporated within this deed.

SECOND SCHEDULE "the Development"

Erection of a residential dwelling and garage as described in the Planning Application.

THIRD SCHEDULE Recreational Disturbance, Avoidance & Mitigation Contribution (RAMS)

- 1. To pay the Council before commencement of the Development the RAMS contribution being £125.58 less the £124.46 paid on 24/11/2020 due under the planning obligation of 30 May 2019 = £1.12.
- 2. Not to commence the Development unless and until the said RAMS contribution of £1.12 has been paid.
- 3. Notifications and payments shall be marked for the attention of the Section 106 Officer, Tendring District Council, Council Offices, Weeley, Clacton-on-Sea, Essex, CO16 9AJ or via email at obligations@tendringdc.gov.uk

FOURTH SCHEDULE Relevant Designated European Wildlife Site

Special Areas of Conservation and Ramsar site(s) at Hamford Water Ramsar and SPA designated primarily to protect waders & wildfowl.

FIFTH SCHEDULE Public Open Space Contribution.

- 1. Before commencement of the Development to pay to the Council a Public Open Space Contribution for a four bedroom Dwelling applying Table 4 of the Council's Supplementary Planning Document "Provision of Recreational Open Space for New Development" published in May 2008 then Index Linking using the Index from May 2008 (being 215.1) as the base index and the latest published Index to calculate the percentage change then deducting the sum of £2,292.73 paid on 24/11/2020 due under the planning obligation of 30 May 2019.
- 2. Not to commence the Development unless and until the said Public Open Space Contribution has been paid to the Council.
- 3. Notifications and payments shall be marked for the attention of the Section106 Officer, Tendring District Council, Council Offices, Weeley, Clacton-on-Sea, Essex, CO16 9AJ or via email at obligations@tendringdc.gov.uk
