The Chief Executive shall determine from time to time what the service responsibilities of the Deputy Chief Executive and each Corporate Director and Head of Service shall be.  (2). Decision Made:	To sign the Enabling Agreement with Calders Conference and World of Travel, in line with Government guidance and through Crown Commercial Procurement Service, for provision of emergency hotel accommodation in the event of an emergency requiring evacuation, and to deliver COVID secure emergency accommodation in line with Government Guidance,
Reason for Decision (if a report was produced to support the Decision, refer to or attach it):	During the COVID-19 Pandemic, it is not possible to run a Rest Centre in response to an emergency in the previous manner. The use of hotel accommodation will assist in providing "isolated" accommodation for those who are critically vulnerable and not positive cases.
	Calders Conferencing have rapid 24/7 access to a wide selection of hotels across the area, which would provide more rapid solutions to this type of accommodation, than trying to source this ourselves.
Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations:	By not having this agreement in place, our ability to provide COVID-19 secure emergency accommodation would be severely hindered.
Details of any Alternative Options Considered and rejected (together with reasons):	The use of more traditional rest centre locations will still be considered, but these are more likely to be for those who have tested positive, and those from a household where there is a positive case.
