M Describe any additional steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives as a result of the proposed variation:

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 11)

- The application is to request an increase of licensing hours for sale of alcohol on a Friday and Saturday night.
- The tenant/DPS and staff members have worked hard through the pandemic problems and have put processes in place to make the British Flag a safe and exceptional place to meet and enjoy other people's company.
- The site has tapped into a source of revenue that is available via customers later of the
 evening. This extra revenue is from a group of engineers and maintenance crew that
 maintain the wind farms and light house boats. All stay locally so there will be no calling of
 taxis later into the night so not cause a nuisance with car doors closing and engines
 running.
- These customers usually over the age of 27 through to 50 and stay in local guest accommodation (guest house/short term let's). Their work and rest times vary but mainly arrive to relax with us about 10pm-11pm most weekends.
- The Premises feel the extra hour will not put any burden on emergency services or create any problems with local residents. The tenant (Peter Vaughan) can be contacted on 07833395012 and is happy to discuss anything in respect to the application.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- The site currently operates an in-house no re-entry policy.
- The times this will be no re-entry after 10pm Monday Thursday and 9pm Sunday.
- No re-entry for new customers past 11pm on a Friday and Saturday night.
- CCTV system in place.

c) Public safety

- CCTV system in place.
- During these restrictions everyone must electronically sign in through NHS app (or proof of I'd ie, drivers licence etc)
- The site operates a firm and robust anti-drug and anti-social behavior policy at all times. This includes monitoring the exterior of the Premises and will refuse entry/service when needed.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

- Customers asked to leave quietly, and respect neighbors signage placed around the premises
- The site only allows background music at a reduced level after 11pm during the week and 12mid night Friday and Saturday.

e) The protection of children from harm

• The site operates a strict all under 18 policy (must be accompanied by a responsible adult) and the responsible adult must remain sober, also no under 18 after 8pm daily.
