Reason for Decision (if a report was produced to support the Decision, refer to or attach it):	Prior to deciding which product to use on a temporary basis different solutions were explored and tested for VFM and suitability requirements. The Auditel products have been tested through several hiring arrangements throughout the pandemic to ensure that democracy was both audible and visually accessible by the public. Surveys were undertaken with elected members and the result were positive. The equipment is available to purchase through a Framework Agreement, with a direct award to the Supplier and fulfils the requirements of the Council's Procurement Procedure Rules.

Good quality microphones and the hearing loop enables the Council to comply with its equality duties for the hard of hearing.
