Dear Cllr Porter,

As you are aware, TDC Sports Facilities (Clacton Leisure Centre, Walton-on-the-Naze Lifestyles & Dovercourt Bay Lifestyles) have been investigating ways in which the facilities can become more efficient & effective whilst managing our budgets. Centre Managers identified five key areas where Contractors could complete works under a single Contract across all three Sports Facilities. The Centres currently utilise multiple contractors completing differing works across TDC's three Sports Facilities. Amalgamating these would then make the Management of Contractors easier & would enable savings by grouping work together.

A procurement process has been completed with ECC Essex County Council for Legionella Control, Electrical Compliance, Air Conditioning, Heating & Air Handling, and Pool Plant Maintenance. These are the main five areas where Sports Facilities could see saving by grouping works together under a single contract & this would also enable Centre Managers to ensure a set standard of compliance across all sites
