In accordance with Section 36 of the Representation of the People Act 1983, when the ordinary elections of (a) district councillor(s) is combined with the election of parish councillors one half of the shared costs shall be attributed to the holding of those parish councillor elections. All of the non-shared costs will be attributed directly to parish councillor elections.
