I hope this email finds you well.

As you will be aware following your meeting on Monday with Lee Heley and Mike Carran, following the concurrence published on 13th February 2023 regarding the allocations for year 1 of the Shared Prosperity Fund, due to the high volume of applications received for this round of the Sports and Leisure Widening Participation grants, it is proposed to award the 2023/24 funding allocation from this round of applications.

Following a review of applications by the Sport & Leisure Team, with support from the Economic Growth Team, 25 successful applications were received, totalling £19,995.59. It therefore is proposed to award £9,995.59 of the 2023/24 allocation to applications received in the current round of funding, in addition to the existing £10,000 allocated for 2022/23, thus avoiding asking otherwise successful applicants to resubmit. This will result in a total award of £19,995.59.
