| Decision Made: | To exercise the option to extend the current glass bank contract, awarded to United Resource Management (URM) by one additional year to commence 1st December 2023 at fixed rate cost of £25 per tonne glass collected. |
| Reason for Decision (if a report was produced to | To extend contract is an option within the current contract and URM have indicated acceptance to continue service for extension period at a lower cost of £25 per tonne, compared to current £27.50 per tonne. |



| support the Decision, refer to or attach it): | Based on 2022 tonnage data this lower cost equates to a cost reduction of £6,913 for the one year period. |
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| Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations: | Bring sites are the most convenient option for residents of Tendring to recycle their glass. Failure to appoint a contractor will result in reduced recycling of glass, increased fly tipping along with loss of recycling credit revenue. |
| Details of any Alternative Options Considered and rejected (together with reasons): | To go back out to market through competitive tender process for a new contract, however this option was rejected as the current contract was procured in 2021 following competitive tender process and contains the option to extend for an additional one year. The incumbent contractor was the most economically viable option at the point of procurement. |
