Dear Sir,

Following up previous contact I would like to inform you of, and confirm, the dangerous condition of the extremely tall and fragile trees on the boundary of Weeley Bridge Caravan Park.

The trees are not safe and are a danger to life and the most recent fall, which has caused a great deal of damage could have killed anybody working in that area.

I am shocked that Park Dean and the management have not dealt with this situation as, if the latest collapse had fallen the other way it would have destroyed one of their mobile homes.

I trust that you will treat this with the urgency it requires and that you will update me, either through email or by email on [REDACTED].
