LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS ACT) 1976 Tree adjacent to Public Right of Way 169_42 Low Road, Dovercourt

I refer to your e-mail dated 22 January 2024 relating to your concerns about the safety of the row of Lombardy Poplar trees situated on the boundary of Weeley Bridge Caravan Park and adjacent to your business premises.

I can confirm that I visited the site on 24 January 2024 in order to carry out an inspection of the trees in accordance with the powers bestowed on the local planning authority by sections 23 and 24 of the above act.

I have attached a copy of my report for you information and convenience.

As you will see, from the contents of the report, the trees are not considered to be in such a condition that they are in an imminently dangerous and that no direct action will be taken by Tendring District Council at the present time.

As you will also see from my report the General Manger of the site has confirmed that an inspection of the trees has been carried out and that some works are planned in the coming months.

I have made a file note to re-visit the site in the summer to re-inspect the trees once the proposed works have been completed.
