Decision Made:	The Portfolio Holder for Leisure & Public Realm and Holder for Environment concurs and approves the external (Tuckwell's) purchase of equipment from the Sport and Leisure Service and for the income generated to be allocated to the Beach Patrol Account.
Reason for Decision (if a report was produced to support the Decision, refer to or attach it):	Currently, the previous Mule has been stored at Northbourne Depot following a replacement being bought due to the condition and cost of repair of the previous Mule. Tuckwell's have made an offer for this when assessing equipment at Northbourne Depot. As there is no other use for this and repairs would not prolong the life of the equipment to gain good value from it, this would be the best option to recoup costs from this vehicle.
