

	Leader of the Council	<p>Following consultation with the Monitoring Officer, and Assistant Director for Partnerships to extend the current Health Inequality Subsidy Scheme (along the same principles of the decisions of Cabinet in July 2023) for a further year to cover 2024-25, prior to any payments being made.</p> <p>The Scheme will be extended as set out in Appendix A to this decision.</p>	<p>A Subsidy Scheme was developed in 2023-24 for allocating funding to address health inequality and the wider determinants of health including the provision of benefits advice and advice and support for residents.</p> <p>The Scheme allowed for a payment to Citizen's Advice Tending who deliver a benefits and wider advice and support service and identified their capabilities to provide the service, the quality of the service and their standing as a trusted brand.</p> <p>Although the funding is being considered as part of a wider External Funding review in accordance with Best Value guidance notice is required to cease the existing agreement ,</p>	<p>Not to extend the Scheme however, this would result in funding to CAT ceasing , although notice to do so is required in accordance with Best Value guidance.
