

Officer Report

The proposed works to clear vegetation from the seaward side of the seawall involves primarily the removal of scrubby growth and brambles .

There is a single Blackthorn at the eastern end of the seawall, close to the co-op car park, which falls within the scope of conservation area controls otherwise all of the vegetation identified for removal is too small to require the service of a section 211 notice .

The removal of the single Blackthorn tree will not adversely affect the character appearance of the conservation area. Consequently there is no objection to its removal.
