The trees were inspected during a recent visit on 18 December 2024.

The proposed reduction of the Ash tree is reasonable and necessary in order to contain it at a size and scale proportionate to its location.

The Eucalyptus is growing in an inappropriate location and is not viable in the long-term. The growth potential of the tree means that it will rapidly outgrow its location. The only practical option is to remove the tree to avoid future problems.
