The proposal to reduce the crowns of two eucalyptus by approximately 50% is reasonable and necessary in order to minimise the adverse impact on adjacent properties and to keep the trees at a size and scale proportionate to their location .

The third tree has shifted in the soil sometime ago and the exposed root plate has revealed large roots above soil level on the windward side of the tree. For this reason the tree is potentially unstable and consequently requires removal on safety grounds.

Decision - No objection
