Road 3 - Longhorn Lane (reason) – Road name is derived from the breeds of livestock that graze the St Osyth Priory.

Road 4 - Portland Street (reason) – Road name is derived from the breeds of livestock that graze the St Osyth Priory.

Road 5 - Hebridean Way (reason) – Road name is derived from the breeds of livestock that graze the St Osyth Priory.

Road 6 - Shepherds Drive (reason) – Acknowledging the Loyal and Ancient Order of Shepherds, who founded a convalescent home in 1948.

Road 7 - Fallow Way (reason) – Reflects the previous use of land on which cattle once grazed.
