Request for Consent to gain Exemption from Call-in Procedure

I / The Cabinet¹ propose to make the following executive decision:-

To submit traffic regulation orders for North Road Great Clacton, Brighton Road Holland on Sea and A133/School Lane Elmstead Market, to the North Essex Parking Partnership to proceed with formal consultation.
