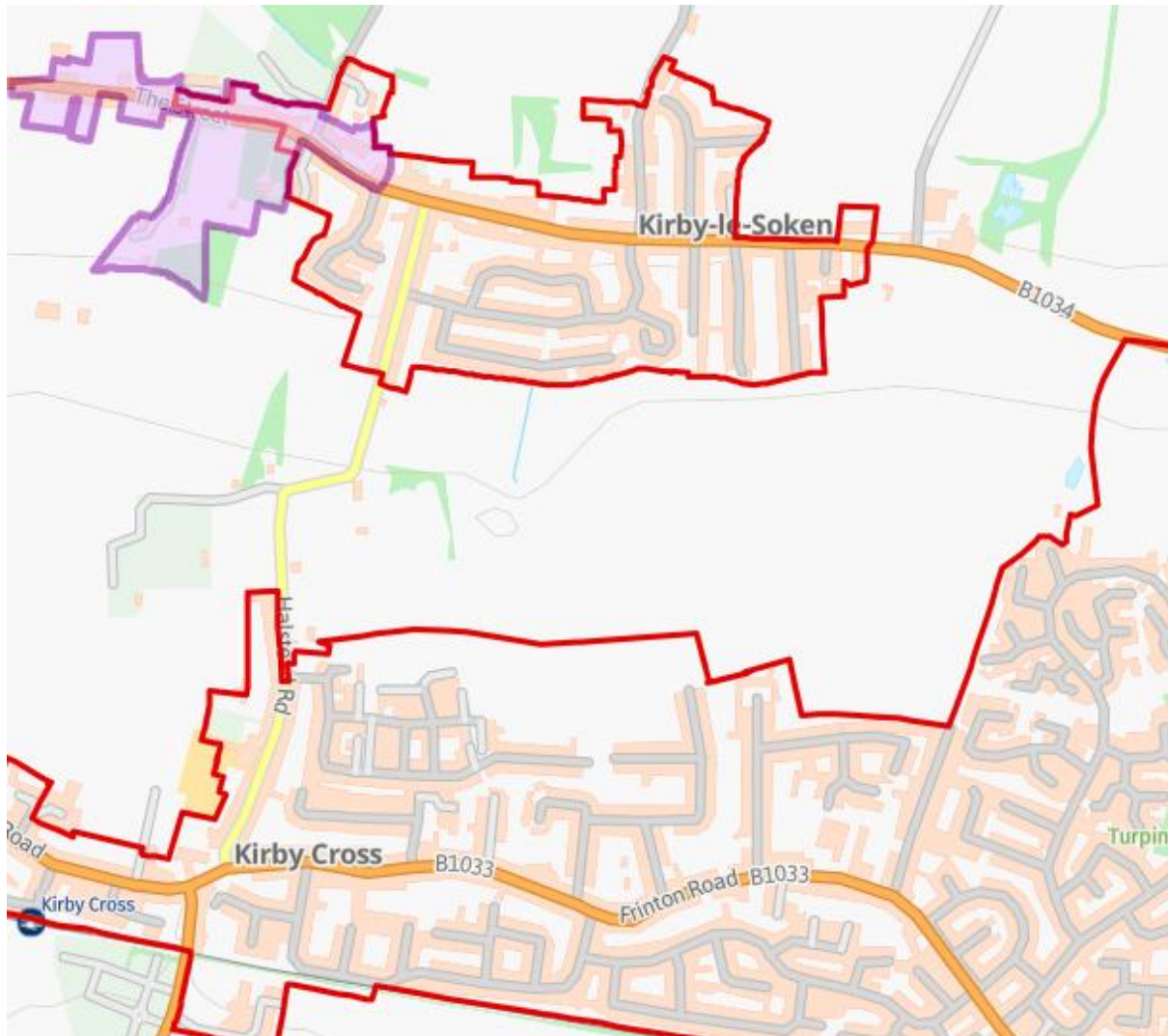

Attached are application form and screen shots x 3 off showing coordinate of location. Followed by photos of some of the trees and the nearing development.x 4 off

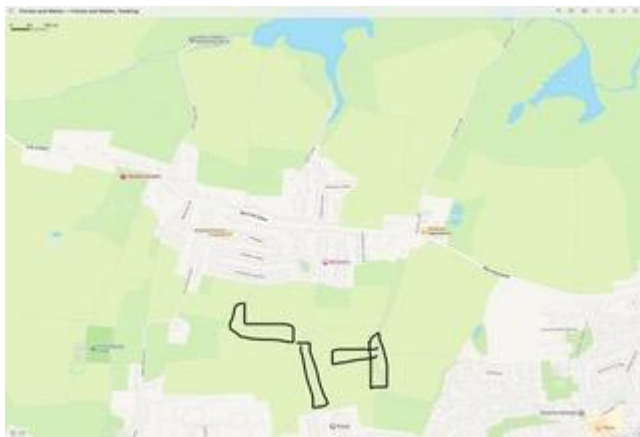
I have also marked on screenshots google maps the location of the trees that need a look at. X 4 off
