Subject: Alresford Hall - Residents Proposed Licensing Conditions

Dear Mr Cook,

Further to my previous correspondence, please find below the minimum conditions which affected residents consider necessary to reduce the most serious public nuisance and public safety risks arising from the proposed event.

These conditions are not excessive. They are the minimum controls required for an event which, even if conditioned, would remain highly disruptive in this quiet rural residential location. Without these controls, residents do not consider it credible that the licensing objectives - particularly the prevention of public nuisance and public safety - would be promoted.

Residents' Minimum Conditions

1. No amplified music, late-night refreshment, external bar/campsite activity after 21:00.
2. No PA, amplified speech, commentary, announcements or amplified sound outside the assessed marquee/tent, except emergency safety announcements.
3. No cannon fire. Fallback: one cannon per side, six shots total per day, no simultaneous fire, minimum five-minute gap, and immediate cessation trigger.
4. Live receptor monitoring at agreed residential locations, defined thresholds, written logs, data shared with Environmental Health and residents, and immediate reduction/cessation trigger.
5. Quiet campsite regime after 21:00, with active security and marshalling.
6. No event-related vehicle or pedestrian movement past Hall Cottage, West Cottage or Lodge Cottage, or along the shared residential track, except in emergency. This must include effective marshalling and physical/operational controls to prevent public attendees, re-enactors, staff, traders, contractors or suppliers accessing residential areas, including the section of track serving Hall Cottage and West Cottage.
7. Full Event Management Plan, including security, marshalling, access, emergency access, parking, pedestrian routing, residential-area exclusion, site containment and crowd-management arrangements, to be provided, reviewed and approved before the event.

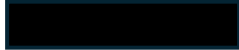

8. Maximum attendance/capacity limits to be clearly specified and conditioned, including maximum public attendance, maximum number of re-enactors/campers, and any maximum number of persons permitted within the licensed/event areas at any one time.
